MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JANUARY

Pacific Northwest (FO 124)

Producers delivered a total of 769.5 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 24.8 million pounds, up 22.9 percent from December. An estimated 477 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 52,036 pounds, up 0.8 percent from December.

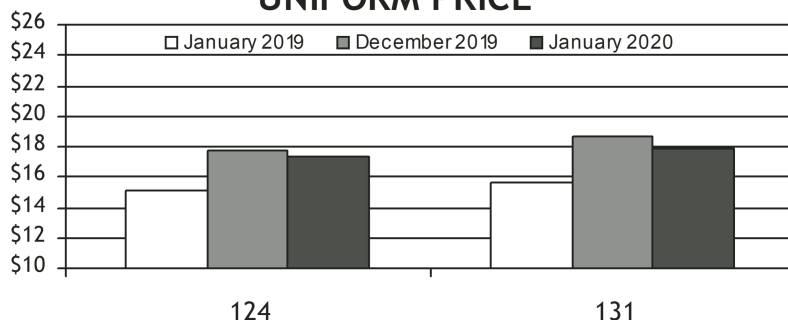
Class I producer milk during January totaled 149.2 million pounds, 19.39 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 4.8 million pounds, up 3.9 percent from December. ▼

Arizona (FO 131)

Producers delivered a total of 442.9 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 14.3 million pounds, up 14.9 percent from December. An estimated 69 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 207,078 pounds, up 14.9 percent from December.

Class I producer milk during January totaled 108.3 million pounds, 24.5 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.5 million pounds, up 1.1 percent from December. ▼

CURRENT COMMODITY PRICES

The AMS survey of cheddar cheese prices showed an increase in prices received for 40-pound blocks and a decrease for 500-pound barrels. The survey of 40-pound blocks showed an increase of 8.21 cents between the January 18 and the February 15 surveys, to \$1.9711 per pound. The survey of 500-pound barrels (adjusted to 38% moisture) showed a decrease of 9.22 cents to \$1.5936 per pound.

The AMS butter price showed a decrease of 12.92 cents between the weeks ending January 18 and February 15 from \$1.9549 per pound to \$1.8257 per pound. The AMS nonfat dry milk showed a net increase of 1.11 cents since mid-January to \$1.2540 per pound. The average price for AMS whey showed an increase of 3.12 cents since mid-January to \$0.3654 per pound. 🐄

USDA ANNOUNCES ISSUANCE OF APPROVALS FOR MILK DONATION REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

On February 6, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced the approval of 133 partnerships as a result of the first round of Milk Donation Reimbursement Program applications. USDA also announced that it will continue accepting applications for the Milk Donation Reimbursement Program for fiscal years 2019 and 2020 through May 1 and October 30, 2020, respectively.

Approved partnerships can now submit claims for reimbursement of eligible expenses related to approved fluid milk product donations.

The Milk Donation Reimbursement Program was established in accordance with the Agriculture Improvement Act of 2018 (2018 Farm Bill). The new program was effective September 16, 2019, and applications were collected through December 2019. Under the program, eligible dairy organizations partner with non-profit organizations to distribute food to low-income individuals. Those partnerships may apply for and receive limited reimbursements to cover expenses related to certain fluid milk product donations.

Congress directed USDA to develop the program to reduce food waste and provide nutrition assistance to low-income individuals. Congress authorized \$9 million for the program in fiscal year 2019 and \$5 million per fiscal year thereafter.
