### MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JANUARY

#### Pacific Northwest (FO 124)

Producers delivered a total of 620.0 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 20.0 million pounds, up 1.5 percent from December. An estimated 354 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 56,497 pounds, up 1.5 percent from December.

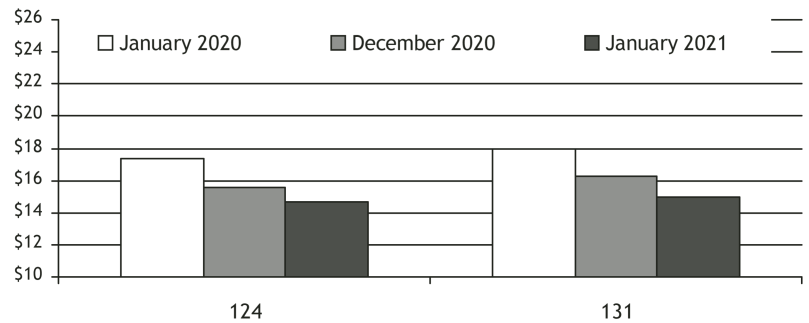
Class I producer milk during January totaled 137.4 million pounds, 22.2 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 4.4 million pounds, down 6.3 percent from December. ▼

#### Arizona (FO 131)

Producers delivered a total of 352.1 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 11.4 million pounds, down 19.7 percent from December. An estimated 71 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 159,994 pounds, down 19.7 percent from December.

Class I producer milk during January totaled 104.6 million pounds, 29.7 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.4 million pounds, down 5.8 percent from December. ▼

## CURRENT COMMODITY PRICES

The AMS survey of cheddar cheese prices showed a net decrease in prices received for 40-pound blocks and a net decrease for 500-pound barrels. The survey of 40-pound blocks showed a net decrease of 2.10 cents between the January 16 and the February 13 surveys, to \$1.6782 per pound. The survey of 500-pound barrels (adjusted to 38% moisture) showed a net decrease of 11.60 cents to \$1.4658 per pound.

The AMS butter price showed a net decrease of 13.05 cents between the weeks ending January 16 and February 13 from \$1.4637 per pound to \$1.3332 per pound. The AMS nonfat dry milk showed a net decrease of 0.60 cents since mid-January to \$1.1280 per pound. The average price for AMS whey showed an increase of 4.56 cents since mid-January to \$0.5033 per pound. 🍌
