MARKET SUMMARIES FOR OCTOBER

Pacific Northwest (FO 124)

Producers delivered a total of 577.9 million pounds of milk to the market during October. Daily deliveries averaged 18.6 million pounds, down 1.4 percent from September. An estimated 339 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 54,994 pounds, down 1.4 percent from September.

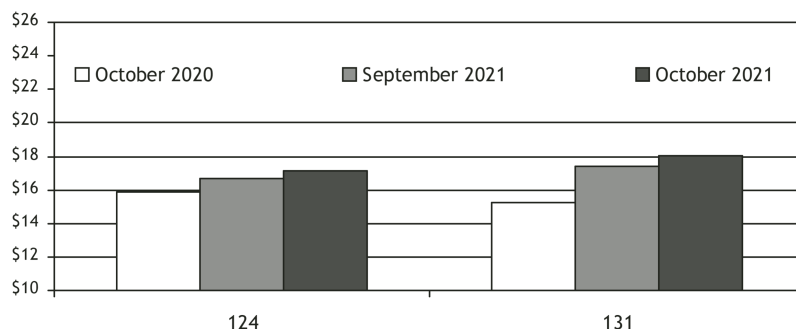
Class I producer milk during October totaled 134.3 million pounds, 23.24 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 4.3 million pounds, down 4.0 percent from September. ▼

Arizona (FO 131)

Producers delivered a total of 367.4 million pounds of milk to the market during October. Daily deliveries averaged 11.9 million pounds, down 2.0 percent from September. An estimated 64 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 185,186 pounds, down 2.0 percent from September.

Class I producer milk during October totaled 118.4 million pounds, 32.22 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.8 million pounds, down 3.3 percent from September. ▼

CURRENT COMMODITY PRICES

The AMS survey of cheddar cheese prices showed a net decrease in prices received for 40-pound blocks and a net increase for 500-pound barrels. The survey of 40-pound blocks showed a net decrease of 5.06 cents between the October 16 and the November 13 surveys, to \$1.7571 per pound. The survey of 500-pound barrels (adjusted to 38% moisture) showed a net increase of 2.57 cents to \$1.7485 per pound.

The AMS butter price showed an increase of 23.50 cents between the weeks ending October 16 and November 13 from \$1.7249 per pound to \$1.9599 per pound. The AMS nonfat dry milk showed an increase of 13.33 cents since mid-October to \$1.4873 per pound. The average price for AMS whey showed a net increase of 3.06 cents since mid-October to \$0.5718 per pound. 🐄
