MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JANUARY

Pacific Northwest (FO 124)

Producers delivered a total of 716.7 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 23.1 million pounds, up 1.5 percent from December. An estimated 414 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 55,844 pounds, up 1.5 percent from December.

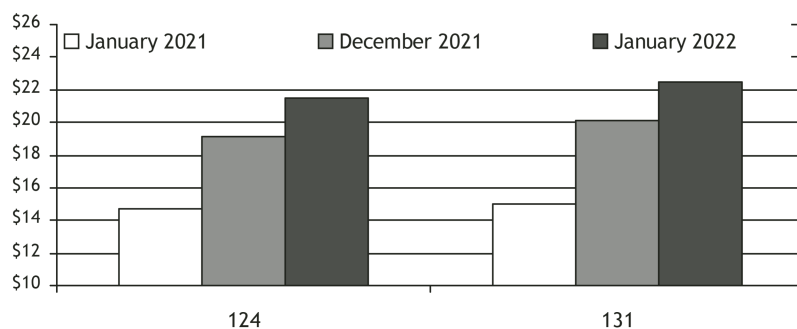
Class I producer milk during January totaled 140.7 million pounds, 19.6 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 4.5 million pounds, up 1.4 percent from December. ▼

Arizona (FO 131)

Producers delivered a total of 433.7 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 14.0 million pounds, up 1.7 percent from December. An estimated 66 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 211,965 pounds, up 1.7 percent from December.

Class I producer milk during January totaled 118.6 million pounds, 27.3 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.8 million pounds, down 8.7 percent from December. ▼

CURRENT COMMODITY PRICES

The AMS survey of cheddar cheese prices showed a net decrease in prices received for 40-pound blocks and a net increase for 500-pound barrels. The survey of 40-pound blocks showed a net decrease of 9.69 cents between the January 15 and the February 12 surveys, to \$1.8786 per pound. The survey of 500-pound barrels (adjusted to 38% moisture) showed a net increase of 10.21 cents to \$1.8526 per pound.

The AMS butter price showed a net increase of 1.55 cents between the weeks ending January 15 and February 12 from \$2.5915 per pound to \$2.6070 per pound. The AMS nonfat dry milk showed an increase of 9.10 cents since mid-January to \$1.7225 per pound. The average price for AMS whey showed an increase of 7.75 cents since mid-January to \$0.7787 per pound. 🐄

USDA EXTENDS 2022 DAIRY MARGIN COVERAGE SIGNUP

The following is an excerpt of a statement released by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) on February 8, 2022.

USDA has extended the deadline to enroll in Dairy Margin Coverage (DMC) and Supplemental Dairy Margin Coverage (SDMC) for program year 2022. The deadline to apply for 2022 coverage is now March 25, 2022. As part of the Biden-Harris Administration's ongoing efforts to support dairy farmers and rural communities, USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA) opened DMC and SDMC signup in December 2021 to help producers manage economic risk brought on by milk price and feed cost disparities.

Enrollment for 2022 DMC is currently at approximately 55% of the 2021 program year enrollment. Producers who enrolled in DMC for 2021 received margin payments each month, January through November for a total of \$1.2 billion, with an average payment of \$60,275 per operation. After making any revisions to 2021 DMC contracts for Supplemental DMC, producers can sign up for 2022 coverage. DMC provides eligible dairy producers with risk management coverage that pays producers when the difference between the price of milk and the cost of feed falls below a certain level. In 2021, based on data to date, DMC payments have triggered for January through November for more than \$1 billion. For DMC enrollment, producers must certify with FSA that the operation is commercially marketing milk, sign all required forms and pay the \$100 administrative fee. The fee is waived for farmers who are considered limited resource, beginning, socially disadvantaged, or a military veteran. To determine the appropriate level of DMC coverage for a specific dairy operation, producers can use the online [dairy decision tool](#).

To locate their local FSA office, producers can visit farmers.gov/service-center-locator. Service Center staff continue to work with agricultural producers via phone, email, and other digital tools. Due to the pandemic, some USDA Service Centers are open to limited visitors.

USDA RELEASES COST OF DAIRY PROCESSING STUDY, WILL HOST A WEBINAR ON THE STUDY

On February 14, the USDA announced the release of a Cost of Processing Study for Cheese, Whey, Butter and Nonfat Dry Milk Plants. The study gathered data from dairy processing plants located throughout the country to estimate the average costs of manufacturing a pound of four dairy commodity products (cheddar cheese, butter, dry whey and nonfat dry milk) that are used in Federal milk marketing order (FMMO) price formulas.

The study results are being released to provide data for interested parties to consider as they determine whether to seek changes to the FMMO price formulas. The study can be found at www.ams.usda.gov/rules-regulations/moa/dairy.

The study was conducted by Dr. Mark Stephenson, Director of Dairy Policy Analysis at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, at the request of USDA.
