MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JANUARY

Pacific Northwest (FO 124)

Producers delivered a total of 709.4 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 22.9 million pounds, up 18.3 percent from December. An estimated 392 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 58,375 pounds, down 10.7 percent from December.

Class I producer milk during January totaled 144.0 million pounds, 20.3 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 4.6 million pounds, up 2.1 percent from December. ▼

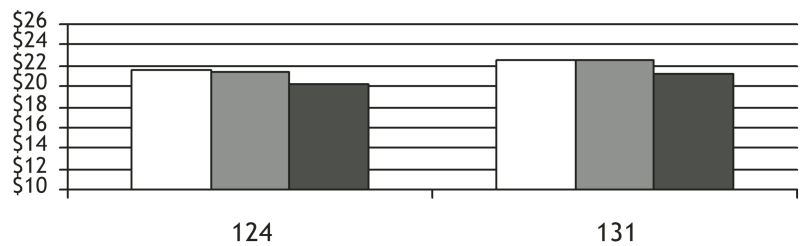
Arizona (FO 131)

Producers delivered a total of 445.6 million pounds of milk to the market during January. Daily deliveries averaged 14.4 million pounds, up 0.5 percent from December. An estimated 67 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 214,525 pounds, up 0.5 percent from December.

Class I producer milk during January totaled 120.7 million pounds, 27.1 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.9 million pounds, down 0.2 percent from December. ▼
