### MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JUNE

#### Pacific Northwest (FO 124)

Producers delivered a total of 597.6 million pounds of milk to the market during June. Daily deliveries averaged 19.9 million pounds, down 2.1 percent from May. An estimated 250 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 79,678 pounds, down 2.1 percent from May.

Class I producer milk during June totaled 111.8 million pounds, 18.7 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.7 million pounds, down 13.2 percent from May. 📉

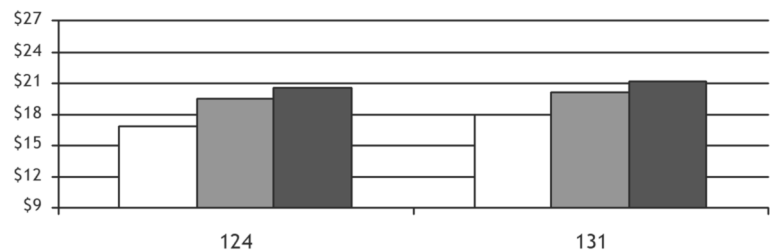
#### Arizona (FO 131)

Producers delivered a total of 304.5 million pounds of milk to the market during June. Daily deliveries averaged 10.2 million pounds, up 7.7 percent from May. An estimated 53 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 191,540 pounds, up 7.7 percent from May.

Class I producer milk during June totaled 86.9 million pounds, 28.5 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.9 million pounds, down 18.5 percent from May. 📉

## CURRENT COMMODITY PRICES

The AMS survey of cheddar cheese prices showed an increase in prices received for 40-pound blocks and a net decrease for 500-pound barrels. The survey of 40-pound blocks showed an increase of 4.24 cents between the June 15 and the July 13 surveys, to \$1.9397 per pound. The survey of 500-pound barrels (adjusted to 38% moisture) showed a net decrease of 6.08 cents to \$1.9655 per pound.

The AMS butter price showed a net increase of 1.11 cents between the weeks ending June 15 and July 13 from \$3.1197 per pound to \$3.1308 per pound. The AMS nonfat dry milk showed a net increase of 2.60 cents since mid-June to \$1.2007 per pound. The average price for AMS whey showed a net increase of 2.79 cents since mid-June to \$0.4466 per pound. 🐄
