

## MILK MARKET SUMMARIES FOR FEBRUARY 2002

James R. Daugherty, market administrator for the Pacific Northwest (FO 124), Western (FO 135), and Arizona-Las Vegas (FO 131) Federal milk orders, reports the following market information for the month of February 2002.

### Pacific Northwest

Producers delivered a total of 592.7 million pounds of milk to the market during February. Daily deliveries averaged 21.2 million pounds, up 4.4 percent from January. An estimated 1,170 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 18,092 pounds, up 4.4 percent from January.

Class I producer milk during February totaled 161.8 million pounds, 27.3% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 5.8 million pounds, down 4.2 percent from January.

### Western

Producers delivered a total of 450.7 million pounds of milk to the market during February. Daily deliveries averaged 16.1 million pounds, up 4.7 percent from January. An estimated 781 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 20,611 pounds, up 4.7 percent from January.

Class I producer milk during February totaled 78.2 million pounds, 17.4% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.8 million pounds, down 4.0 percent from January.

### Arizona-Las Vegas

Producers delivered a total of 247.4 million pounds of milk to the market during February. Daily deliveries averaged 8.8 million pounds, up 5.0 percent from January. An estimated 110 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 80,332 pounds, up 5.0 percent from January.

Class I producer milk during February totaled 76.2 million pounds, 30.8% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.7 million pounds, down 0.4 percent from January.
