\* Price formula:  $\frac{((\text{Percent Skim} \times \text{Skim Price}) / 100 + (\text{Percent Butterfat} \times \text{Butterfat Price}))}{100} \times \text{Conversion Factor}$

For example, the formula for a gallon of whole milk would be:  $\frac{((96.75 \times \text{Skim Price}) / 100 + (3.25 \times \text{Butterfat Price}))}{100} \times 8.6$

\*\* Conversion factors for chocolate milk vary between products.
